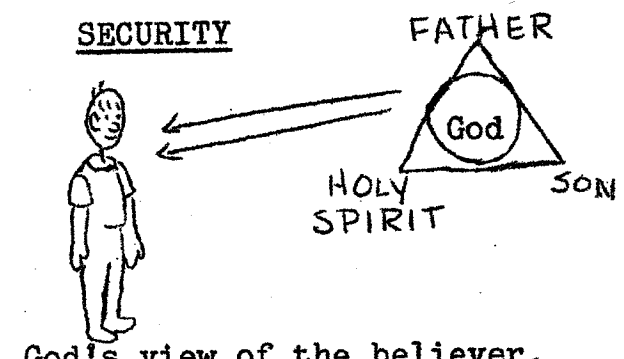


We now want to study the place and reason for the believer's personal assurance of salvation.

Assurance is the complete or entire confidence and certainty that all is right in the believer's relationship to the living God.



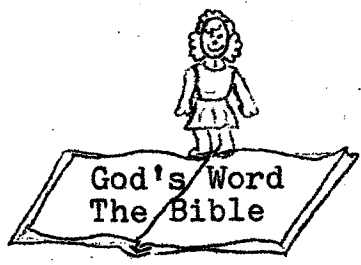
Believer's view of God and His Word.

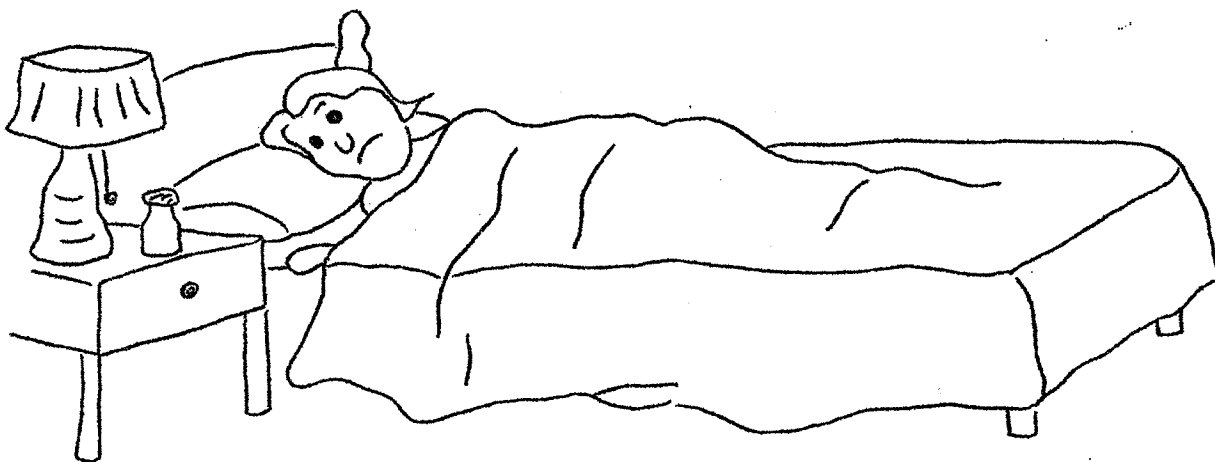

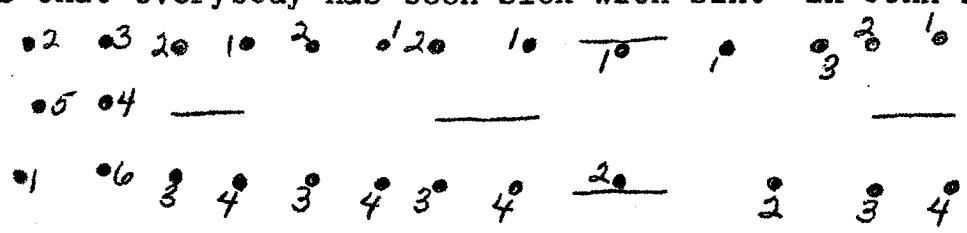

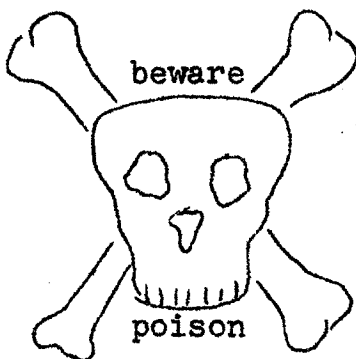
