Howland and wife, fellow *Mayflower* passenger Elizabeth Tilley had ten children and 88 grandchildren. ^[1] The couple founded one of the three largest *Mayflower* progenies and their descendants have been "associated largely with both the 'Boston Brahmins' and Harvard's 'intellectual aristocracy' of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. ^[citation needed] (LINK ROT on old one.)
