☛ **Don't forget your former unsaved condition.** “Remember...that at that time ye were without Christ...having no hope, and without God in the world” (*Eph. 2:11-12*).

☛ **Don't forget that God has redeemed you.** “Beware lest thou forget the LORD, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage” (*Deut. 6:12*). God has redeemed us from the bondage and slave market of sin.

☛ **Don't forget Calvary.** “Do this in remembrance of Me” (*1 Cor. 11:24-26*).

☛ **Don't forget to obey God.** “Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping His commandments” (*Deut. 8:11*).


