

# Can't do without

1. **John 15:5** I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for **WITHOUT** Me you can do nothing.
2. **1 Cor. 13:2** And though I have *the gift of* prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, **BUT HAVE NOT LOVE**, I am nothing.
3. **Eph. 2:12** That at that time you were **WITHOUT** Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and **WITHOUT** God in the world.
4. **Heb. 9:22** And according to the law almost all things are purged with blood, and **WITHOUT** shedding of blood there is no remission.
5. **Heb. 11:6** But **WITHOUT** faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
6. **Heb. 12:8** But if you are **WITHOUT** chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.
7. **Heb. 12:14** Pursue peace with all *men*, and holiness, **WITHOUT** which no one will see the Lord.
8. **James 2:26** For as the body **WITHOUT** the spirit is dead, so faith **WITHOUT** works is dead also.

# Can do without!

1. **Rom. 12:9** Let love be **WITHOUT** hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
2. **1 Cor. 7:32** But I want you to be **WITHOUT** care. He who is unmarried cares for the things *that belong* to the Lord;

how he may please the Lord.

3. **Eph. 1:4** ...just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and **WITHOUT** blame before Him[,] in love....
4. **Phil. 1:10** ...that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and **WITHOUT** offense till the day of Christ.
5. **Phil. 1:14** ...and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word **WITHOUT** fear.
6. **Phil. 2:14** Do all things **WITHOUT** murmuring and disputing....
7. **Phil. 2:15** ...that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God **WITHOUT** fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world.
8. **1 Tim. 2:8** Therefore I desire that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, **WITHOUT** wrath and doubting;
9. **1 Tim. 5:21** I charge *you* before God and the Lord Jesus Christ and the elect angels that you observe these things **WITHOUT** prejudice, doing nothing with partiality.
10. **1 Tim. 6:14** ...that you keep *this* commandment **WITHOUT** spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing....
11. **Heb. 13:5** Let your conduct be **WITHOUT** covetousness, and be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."
12. **James 3:17** But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, **WITHOUT** partiality and **WITHOUT** hypocrisy.
13. **1 Pet. 4:9** Be hospitable to one another **WITHOUT** grumbling.
